

Video Transcript: Excerpts from Interviews with Sunrise School Students Attending A Blue So Blue

Jessica Ryan: Did you like the concert today?

Daniel: Yes

Jessica: What did you like about it?

Daniel: The song

Jessica: The conductor was really great, wasn't he?

Daniel: Yeah

Jessica: And did I hear that you wanted to be a conductor someday?

Daniel: Yup

Jessica: So do you want to conduct an orchestra like the Pittsburgh Symphony?

Daniel: Yes

[Jessica sings the beginning of Johann Strauss's "The Blue Danube Waltz" until Logan joins in. She stops to let him sing it as a solo, and he stops as well.]

Logan: We could sing in a duet too.

Jessica: You want to sing a duet? Okay.

[Logan and Jessica begin singing again.]

Logan: You too *[motions for others off camera to join in]*

[Logan, Jessica, and the others finish singing an excerpt of the waltz tune.]

Jessica: Wow, good job! So was that your favorite one from today?

Logan: Yeah!

Jessica: So did you like the concert today?

Ha'sawn: Yeah.

Jessica: What especially did you like about it?

Ha'sawn: I liked the drums.

Jessica: Oh yeah, the drums are pretty cool. Do you play drums at all?

Ha'sawn: Yeah

Jessica: And what about other instruments? Are there any other instruments that you like?

Ha'sawn: Trombone

Jessica: Could you see the trombones from where you were sitting?

Ha'sawn: Yeah

Jessica: And how did they look?

Ha'sawn: They looked nice.

Jessica: You've been to Heinz hall before, right?

Ha'sawn: Yes

Jessica: And do you like coming back every year to see the Pittsburgh Symphony?
